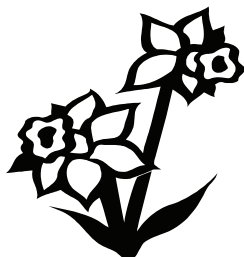
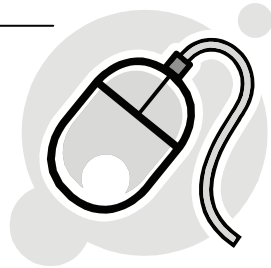
### School Production - The King and I
