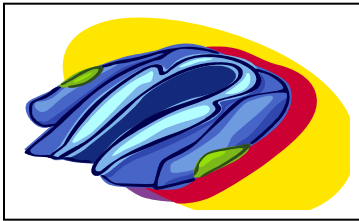


### Pagoda Sales
