Dear Woodley resident,

I am writing to you as someone who has shown a recent interest in helping Woodley to keep clean from litter. You may have taken part in our annual litter pick or simply expressed an interest.

At the beginning of November, Woodley Town Council, along with members of the community of Woodley, will launch the Woodley Adopt a Street Project (WASP). This project is intended to encourage residents to volunteer to care for their communities and local environment by collecting litter from their local streets and areas. This is in addition to the Wokingham Borough regular street cleaning schedule and is not intended to replace this.

The project works by residents choosing an area they would like to 'adopt' and the Council can provide the appropriate equipment such as litter pickers, gloves and plastic bags. Your 'adopted' area can be as small or as large as you choose and the time you give is entirely up to you. Just fit it in when you can. You put the rubbish you collect out with your weekly kerb side collection and Wokingham Borough will collect it in the usual way.

We only ask that people take sensible precautions when litter picking and Health and Safety guidance will be given to everyone taking part. We are asking everyone who is interested to complete a registration of interest form and we will contact you after we receive it to ensure you have all you need.
